AN ACT directing the commissioner of the office of parks, recreation and historic preservation to provide for the re-designation of Donald J. Trump State Park, in Putnam and Westchester counties to a name other than Donald J. Trump State Park

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The commissioner of the office of parks, recreation and historic preservation shall provide for the re-designation of Donald J. Trump State Park, in Putnam and Westchester counties to a name other than Donald J. Trump State Park. The commissioner of the office of parks, recreation and historic preservation shall, subject to an appropriation for such purpose, provide for the installation and maintenance of appropriate signage and any other administrative actions necessary to implement the provisions of this act and to improve the park for the enjoyment of the public.

10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
