AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the "Hoosock and Jensen law" which increases the designation of certain offenses relating to unlawfully fleeing a police officer

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as
2 the "Hoosock and Jensen law".
- 3 § 2. The second undesignated paragraph of section 270.25 of the penal
4 law, as added by chapter 738 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as
5 follows:
6 Unlawful fleeing a police officer in a motor vehicle in the third
7 degree is a class [~~A~~ *~~misdemeanor~~*] *E felony*.
- 8 § 3. The second undesignated paragraph of section 270.30 of the penal
9 law, as added by chapter 738 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as
10 follows:
11 Unlawful fleeing a police officer in a motor vehicle in the second
12 degree is a class [~~E~~] *D violent felony offense*.
- 13 § 4. The second undesignated paragraph of section 270.35 of the penal
14 law, as added by chapter 738 of the laws of 2006, is amended to read as
15 follows:
16 Unlawful fleeing a police officer in a motor vehicle in the first
17 degree is a class [~~D~~] *B violent felony offense*.
- 18 § 5. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-
19 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
