AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to the recognition of the establishment of a workplace safety committee by an employer

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 9 of section 27-d of the labor law, as added by a chapter of the laws of 2022 amending the labor law relating to employer violations of certain provisions allowing for work-place safety committees, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 9450 and A. 10492, is amended to read as follows:

(a) An employer must recognize within [five] fifteen business days the establishment of a workplace safety committee created pursuant to this section. Violations of this subdivision shall result in a civil penalty of not less than fifty dollars per day until the violation is remedied.
