AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to drivers of school buses using hands-free mobile telephones

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 1225-c of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new paragraph (e) to read as follows:

3 (e) No driver of a school bus as defined in section one hundred forty-two of this chapter shall use a hands-free mobile telephone while 4 5 operating a school bus except in the case of an emergency pursuant to б paragraph (a) of subdivision three of this section or if the school bus 7 is parked, for purposes other than dropping off or picking up students, at the side of, or off, a public highway in a location where such vehi-8 cle is not otherwise prohibited from stopping by law, rule, regulation 9 or any lawful order or direction of a police officer. 10

11 § 2. Subdivision 3 of section 1225-c of the vehicle and traffic law, 12 as added by chapter 69 of the laws of 2001, is amended to read as 13 follows:

3. Subdivision two of this section shall not apply to (a) the use of a mobile telephone for the sole purpose of communicating with any of the following regarding an emergency situation: an emergency response operator; a hospital, physician's office or health clinic; an ambulance company or corps; a fire department, district or company; or a police department, (b) any of the following persons while in the performance of their official duties: a police officer or peace officer; a member of a fire department, district or company; or the operator of an authorized emergency vehicle as defined in section one hundred one of this chapter, or (c) the use of a hands-free mobile telephone, except in the case of a
