AN ACT to amend the judiciary law, in relation to removing the lifetime ban on jury duty for convicted felons who have completed their sentencing

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 510 of the judiciary law, as  
2 amended by chapter 86 of the laws of 1995, is amended to read as  
3 follows:  
4 3. [~~Not have been~~] If convicted of a felony, have completed any  
5 sentencing related to such conviction, including any period of probation  
6 or community supervision.  
7 § 2. Section 517 of the judiciary law is amended by adding a new  
8 subdivision (d) to read as follows:  
9 (d) The jury service of any person serving a term of incarceration for  
10 a felony conviction shall be postponed while the person is incarcerated  
11 for such felony.  
12 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
