AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring the department of education to provide school districts with a list of resources and instructional materials on media literacy

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 756 to 2 read as follows:
- § 756. Media literacy materials. 1. For the purposes of this section, the following terms shall have the following meanings:
- 5 <u>a. "digital citizenship" means a diverse set of skills related to</u>
 6 <u>current technology and social media, including the norms of appropriate,</u>
 7 <u>responsible, and healthy behavior.</u>
- 8 <u>b. "media literacy" means the ability to access, analyze, evaluate,</u>
 9 <u>and use media and encompasses the foundational skills that lead to</u>
 10 <u>digital citizenship.</u>
- 2. On or before July first, two thousand twenty-four, the department shall make available to school districts on its internet website a list
- of resources and instructional materials on media literacy, including
- 14 media literacy professional development programs for teachers.
- 15 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
