AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring public schools in any city with a population over one million to offer food options during lunch

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

## Section 1. The education law is amended by adding a new section 915-a to read as follows: § 915-a. Food options. In any city having over one million inhabit-

4 ants, any public school that has students practicing a religious faith
5 with specific dietary restrictions shall offer food options which meet
6 such dietary restrictions upon the students' request.

§ 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred twentieth day after 8 it shall have become a law. Effective immediately, the addition, amend-9 ment and/or repeal of any rules or regulations necessary for the imple-10 mentation of this act on its effective date are authorized to be made on 11 or before such date.
