AN ACT to amend the public health law, in relation to funding for providers who engage in treatment and services for people with  ${\tt HIV/AIDS}$ 

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Paragraph (e) of subdivision 1 of section 2776 of the 2 public health law, as added by chapter 823 of the laws of 1983, is 3 amended to read as follows:
