AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to increasing the income eligibility threshold for the tuition assistance program

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subparagraph (ii) of paragraph a of subdivision 3 of section 667 of the education law, as amended by section 1 of part B of 3 chapter 60 of the laws of 2000, is amended to read as follows:

4 (ii) Except for students as noted in subparagraph (iii) of this para-5 graph, the base amount as determined from subparagraph (i) of this para-6 graph, shall be reduced in relation to income as follows:
