Introduced by M. of A. DINOWITZ -- read once and referred to the Committee on Corporations, Authorities and Commissions

AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to exempting the metropolitan transportation authority from the requirement for public authorities to reimburse the state for services provided to such authorities

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 1 of section 2975 of the public authorities  
2 law, as added by chapter 62 of the laws of 1989, is amended to read as  
3 follows:
- 4 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, every  
5 public authority and every public benefit corporation created by or  
6 pursuant to [~~New York~~] state law at least three of whose members are  
7 appointed by the governor, whether such authority or corporation is  
8 otherwise governed by this chapter (such entities, as so constituted, to  
9 be hereafter in this title referred to as "public benefit corporations"), shall reimburse to [~~New York~~] the state an allocable share of  
10 state governmental costs attributable to the provision of services to  
11 public benefit corporations, as determined [~~herein~~] in this title.  
12 Provided, however, that the provisions of this section and, for the  
13 purposes of this section, the term "public benefit corporation" shall  
14 not include the metropolitan transportation authority, as established in  
15 title eleven of article five of this chapter. The payment of such costs  
16 by public benefit corporations is a valid and proper purpose for which  
17 available authority funds may be applied.
- 18 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
