AN ACT in relation to limiting the liability of a school

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of law, rule or regulation to the contrary, any school that holds in-person instruction in compliance with individual school plans approved by the state departments of education and health and related COVID-19 emergency rules, or otherwise in accordance with applicable law and any further amendments or modifications thereto, shall not be liable for any damages due to a person contracting novel coronavirus, COVID-19, while attending such in-person instruction.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
