AN ACT to amend chapter 397 of the laws of 1996, relating to authorizing the town of Islip to lease certain lands to a business corporation, in relation to the lease term

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of chapter 397 of the laws of 1996, relating to authorizing the town of Islip to lease certain lands to a business corporation, is amended by adding a new subdivision (a-1) to read as follows: <u>(a-1) The town of Islip, in the county of Suffolk, is hereby author-</u> <u>ized and empowered to extend the terms of a lease between the town and a</u> <u>business corporation dated July 30, 1996 that was authorized by this act</u> on the lands described in this act for up to ten years in addition to the ten-year extension authorized under subdivision (a) of this section.

10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
