Introduced by M. of A. DINOWITZ -- read once and referred to the Committee on Health

AN ACT to amend the civil service law, the labor law, the public health law, the education law, the tax law, the vehicle and traffic law, the judiciary law and the executive law, in relation to requiring certain state forms and applications to include space for registering in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations; and to repeal certain provisions of the public health law relating thereto

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The civil service law is amended by adding a new section 2 50-d to read as follows:

§ 50-d. Organ, eye and tissue donation. The civil service department and municipal commissions shall provide on each application provided pursuant to section fifty of this title space for the applicant to register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations established pursuant to section forty-three hundred ten of the public health law with the following stated on the application in clear and conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". Neither the civil service department nor municipal commissions shall maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Provided, that where an applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the "donate life registry", failing to check a box shall not impair such consent or registration.

20 § 2. The labor law is amended by adding a new section 596-a to read as 21 follows:

§ 596-a. Organ, eye and tissue donation. The commissioner shall provide on each claim for benefits made pursuant to section five hundred ninety-six of this title space for the claimant to register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations established pursuant to section forty-three hundred ten of the public health law with the following stated on the application in clear and conspicuous "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The commissioner shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Provided, that where a claimant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the "donate life registry", failing to check a box shall not impair such consent or registration.

- § 3. Paragraph (a) of subdivision 5 of section 4310 of the public health law, as amended by chapter 758 of the laws of 2022, is amended to read as follows:
- 20 (a) Such organ, eye and tissue registration of consent to make an 21 anatomical gift can be made through: (i) indication made on the applica-22 tion or renewal form of a driver's license, (ii) indication made on a 23 non-driver identification card application or renewal form, (iii) indi-24 cation made on a voter registration form pursuant to subdivision five of 25 section 5-210 of the election law, (iv) indication made on the applica-26 tion for, or manual renewal application by an account holder of, health 27 care coverage offered through the state health benefit exchange, (v) 28 enrollment through the donate life registry website, (vi) paper enroll-29 ment submitted to the donate life registry, (vii) indication made on the 30 application or renewal form of a hunting, fishing or trapping license 31 issued pursuant to title seven of article eleven of the environmental 32 conservation law, (viii) indication made on transactions administered by 33 the office of temporary and disability assistance through the mybene-34 fits.ny.gov website, or any such successor website; (ix) indication made 35 on applications, renewals or related transactions for college financial 36 aid, grants, or scholarships offered or administered through any website 37 maintained by the higher education services corporation; (x) indication 38 made by eligible individuals during enrollments, renewals, and other 39 related transactions for health insurance policies covered under this article, section three thousand two hundred sixteen of the insurance 40 law, or section three thousand two hundred twenty-one of the insurance 41 42 [er] (xi) indication made on an application for a civil service 43 examination pursuant to section fifty of the civil service law, (xii) 44 indication made on a claim for unemployment benefits made pursuant to 45 section five hundred ninety-six of the labor law, (xiii) indication made 46 on an application for a certificate, license or registration issued 47 pursuant to article sixty-one of the education law, (xiv) indication made on an application to practice a profession pursuant to title eight 48 of the education law, (xv) indication made on a personal income tax 49 return, (xvi) indication made on an application for registration or 50 renewal thereof of a motor vehicle, (xvii) indication made on an appli-51 52 cation for admission to practice or on a biennial registration form pursuant to section four hundred sixty-four or four hundred 53 54 sixty-eight-a of the judiciary law, (xviii) indication made on an application to conduct a profession or occupation which is licensed or regis-55 tered by the department of state, or (xix) through any other method 56

identified by the commissioner. The department shall establish a means by which to register the consent given by individuals who are sixteen or seventeen years of age in the donate life registry, and shall make registration available by any of the methods provided in subparagraphs (i), (ii), (iii), (iv), (v), (vi), (vii), (viii), (ix), (x) [and], (xi), (xii), (xiii), (xiv), (xv), (xvi), (xvii), (xviii) and (xix) of this paragraph.

- § 4. Paragraphs (b) and (c) of subdivision 5 of section 4310 of the public health law are REPEALED and a new paragraph (b) is added to read as follows:
- (b) Enrollment or amendment or revocation through the donate life registry website through any of the means listed in this subdivision may be signed by electronic signature, in accordance with the provisions of article three of the state technology law, supported by the use of suitable mechanisms including unique identifiers to provide confidence in the identity of the person providing the electronic signature. The registration shall take effect upon the provision of written or electronic notice of the registration to the individual enrolling in the donate life registry.
- § 5. Paragraphs (d), (e) and (f) of subdivision 5 of section 4310 of the public health law are relettered paragraphs (c), (d) and (e).
- § 6. Subdivision 1 of section 206 of the public health law is amended by adding eight new paragraphs (w), (x), (y), (z), (aa), (bb), (cc) and (dd) to read as follows:

25 (w) require, in consultation and cooperation with the civil service department and municipal commissions, that every individual applying for 26 27 a civil service examination be provided space so that such applicant may register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue 28 donations under section forty-three hundred ten of this chapter with the 29 following stated in clear conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added 30 to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this ques-31 32 tion'". Neither the civil service department nor municipal commissions 33 shall maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". 34 Except where the application is made in person or electronically, failure to check a box shall not impair the validity of an application, and 35 36 failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be 37 construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent 38 39 to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Where an applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift 40 or registered in the donate life registry, checking "skip this question" 41 42 or failing to check a box shall not impair that consent or registration. 43 (x) require, in consultation and cooperation with the commissioner of 44 the department of labor, that every individual filing a claim for unem-45 ployment benefits be provided space so that such applicant may register 46 in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations under 47 section forty-three hundred ten of this chapter with the following stated in clear conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate 48 Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The commis-49 sioner shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this 50 question". Except where the claim for benefits is made in person or 51 52 electronically, failure to check a box shall not impair the validity of an application, and failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this ques-53 54 tion" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of a claimant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not 55

constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the

donate life registry. Where a claimant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the donate life registry, checking "skip this question" or failing to check a box shall not impair that consent or registration.

5 (y) require, in consultation and cooperation with the commissioner of 6 education, that every individual applying for a certificate, license or 7 registration issued pursuant to article sixty-one of the education law, 8 be provided space so that such applicant may register in the "donate 9 life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations under section forty-10 three hundred ten of this chapter with the following stated in clear 11 conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Regis-12 try? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The commissioner shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this ques-13 tion". Except where the application is made in person or electronically, 14 15 failure to check a box shall not impair the validity of an application, and failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be 16 17 construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent 18 to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. 19 20 Where an applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift 21 or registered in the donate life registry, checking "skip this question" 22 or failing to check a box shall not impair that consent or registration. 23 (z) require, in consultation and cooperation with the commissioner of education, that every individual applying to practice a profession 24 25 pursuant to title eight of the education law, be provided space so that such applicant may register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye 26 27 and tissue donations under section forty-three hundred ten of this chap-28 ter with the following stated in clear conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip 29 30 this question'". The commissioner shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Except where the application is 31 32 made in person or electronically, failure to check a box shall not 33 impair the validity of an application, and failure to check "yes" or 34 checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, 35 36 checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift 37 or registration in the donate life registry. Where an applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the 38 donate life registry, checking "skip this question" or failing to check 39 40 a box shall not impair that consent or registration.

(aa) require, in consultation and cooperation with the department of taxation and finance, that every individual filing a personal income tax return be provided space so that such applicant may register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations under section forty-three hundred ten of this chapter with the following stated in clear conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The commissioner shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Except where the application is made in person or electronically, failure to check a box shall not impair the validity of an application, and failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Where an applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift

or registered in the donate life registry, checking "skip this question" 1 or failing to check a box shall not impair that consent or registration. 2 3 (bb) require, in consultation and cooperation with the commissioner of 4 motor vehicles, that every individual applying for a registration or 5 renewal thereof of a motor vehicle be provided space so that such appli-6 cant may register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and 7 tissue donations under section forty-three hundred ten of this chapter with the following stated in clear conspicuous type: "Would you like to 8 be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this 9 10 question'". The commissioner shall not maintain records of any person 11 who checks "skip this question". Except where the application is made in 12 person or electronically, failure to check a box shall not impair the validity of an application, and failure to check "yes" or checking "skip 13 this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In 14 15 the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration 16 17 in the donate life registry. Where an applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the donate life registry, 18 checking "skip this question" or failing to check a box shall not impair 19 20 that consent or registration.

(cc) require, in consultation and cooperation with the state board of law examiners, that every individual applying for admission to practice or on a biennial registration form pursuant to section four hundred sixty-four or four hundred sixty-eight-a of the judiciary law, be provided space so that such applicant may register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations under section forty-three hundred ten of this chapter with the following stated in clear conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The commissioner shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Except where the application is made in person or electronically, failure to check a box shall not impair the validity of an application, and failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Where an applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the donate life registry, checking "skip this question" or failing to check a box shall not impair that consent or registration.

(dd) require, in consultation and cooperation with the secretary of state, that every individual applying to conduct a profession or occupation which is licensed or registered by the department of state be provided space so that such applicant may register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations under section forty-three hundred ten of this chapter with the following stated in clear conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The commissioner shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Except where the application is made in person or electronically, failure to check a box shall not impair the validity of an application, and failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Where an applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or regis-

tered in the donate life registry, checking "skip this question" or failing to check a box shall not impair that consent or registration.

- 7. Section 3006 of the education law is amended by adding a new subdivision 4 to read as follows:
- 5 4. Organ, eye and tissue donation. The commissioner shall provide on 6 each application for a certificate, license or registration issued 7 pursuant to this article, and each renewal thereof, space for the appli-8 cant to register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue 9 donations established pursuant to section forty-three hundred ten of the 10 public health law with the following stated on the application in clear 11 and conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life 12 Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The regents shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this ques-13 14 tion". Failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not 15 be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent 16 17 to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Provided, that where an applicant has previously consented to make an 18 anatomical gift or registered in the "donate life registry", failing to 19 20 check a box shall not impair such consent or registration.
- 21 8. Section 6501 of the education law is amended by adding a new 22 subdivision 3 to read as follows:
 - 3. The regents shall provide, on each application to practice a profession pursuant to this title and each application for renewal of a license, registration or certification to practice such a profession, space for the applicant to register in the "donate life registry" of organ, eye and tissue donations established pursuant to section fortythree hundred ten of the public health law with the following stated on the application in clear and conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The regents shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Provided, that where an applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the "donate life registry", failing to check a box shall not impair such consent or registration.
 - § 9. Section 651 of the tax law is amended by adding a new subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- (a-1) Organ, eye and tissue donation. The commissioner shall provide on each return space for the taxpayer or taxpayers to register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations established pursuant to section forty-three hundred ten of the public health law with the following stated on the application in clear and conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The commissioner shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Provided, that where a taxpayer has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the "donate life registry", failing to check a box shall not 56 impair such consent or registration.

§ 10. Paragraph b of subdivision 1 of section 401 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new closing paragraph to read as follows:

The commissioner shall provide on each application for registration 4 5 and renewal thereof space for the motor vehicle owner to register in the 6 "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations established pursuant to section forty-three hundred ten of the public health law 7 8 with the following stated on the application in clear and conspicuous 9 type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box 10 for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The commissioner shall not maintain 11 records of any person who checks "skip this question". Failure to check 12 "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of 13 14 age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical 15 gift or registration in the donate life registry. Provided, that where a 16 motor vehicle owner has previously consented to make an anatomical gift 17 or registered in the "donate life registry", failing to check a box shall not impair such consent or registration. 18

§ 11. Section 464 of the judiciary law is amended by adding a new closing paragraph to read as follows:

The chief administrator of the courts shall provide on each application for admission to practice, space for the applicant to register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations established pursuant to section forty-three hundred ten of the public health law with the following stated on the application in clear and conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The chief administrator of the courts shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Provided, that where an applicant has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the "donate life registry", failing to check a box shall not impair such consent or registration.

§ 12. Section 468-a of the judiciary law is amended by adding a new subdivision 4-a to read as follows:

4-a. The chief administrator shall provide on each biennial registration form space for the attorney to register in the "donate life registry" for organ, eye and tissue donations established pursuant to section forty-three hundred ten of the public health law with the following stated on the application in clear and conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this question'". The chief administrator shall not maintain records of any person who checks "skip this question". Failure to check "yes" or checking "skip this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration in the donate life registry. Provided, that where an attorney has previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the "donate life registry", failing to check a box shall not impair such consent or registration.

§ 13. The executive law is amended by adding a new section 91-a to read as follows:

§ 91-a. Organ, eye and tissue donation. The secretary shall provide on each application to conduct a profession or occupation which is 2 licensed or registered by the department, and each renewal thereof, 3 4 space for the applicant to register in the "donate life registry" for 5 organ, eye and tissue donations established pursuant to section fortythree hundred ten of the public health law with the following stated on 7 the application in clear and conspicuous type: "Would you like to be added to the Donate Life Registry? Check box for 'yes' or 'skip this 8 9 question'". The secretary shall not maintain records of any person who 10 checks "skip this question". Failure to check "yes" or checking "skip 11 this question" shall not be construed to imply a wish not to donate. In 12 the case of an applicant under sixteen years of age, checking "yes" shall not constitute consent to make an anatomical gift or registration 13 14 in the donate life registry. Provided, that where an applicant has 15 previously consented to make an anatomical gift or registered in the 16 "donate life registry", failing to check a box shall not impair such 17 consent or registration.

§ 14. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeeding the date on which it shall have become a law; provided, however, that section three of this act shall take effect on the same date and in 20 21 the same manner as chapter 758 of the laws of 2022 takes effect. Effective immediately, the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or 23 regulation necessary for the implementation of this act on its effective 24 date are authorized to be made and completed on or before such effective 25 date.
