AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to classifying criminal possession of a firearm from a class E felony to a class D felony

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 265.01-b of the penal law, as added by chapter 1 of 2 the laws of 2013, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 § 265.01-b Criminal possession of a firearm.
 4 A person is guilty of criminal possession of a firearm when he or she:
- 5 (1) possesses any firearm or; (2) lawfully possesses a firearm prior to
- 6 the effective date of $[\frac{\text{the}}{\text{chapter one}}]$ of the laws of two thousand
- 7 thirteen [which added this section] subject to the registration require-
- 8 ments of subdivision sixteen-a of section 400.00 of this chapter and 9 knowingly fails to register such firearm pursuant to such subdivision.
- 10 Criminal possession of a firearm is a class [E] D felony.
- 11 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall
- 12 have become a law.
