AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to establishing the crime of making a terroristic threat against a police officer

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 490.21 to 2 read as follows:
- 3 § 490.21 Making a terroristic threat against a police officer.
- 1. A person is quilty of making a terroristic threat against a police officer when with intent to intimidate or coerce a civilian population, influence the policy of a unit of government by intimidation or coercion, or affect the conduct of a unit of government by murder, assassination or kidnapping, he or she threatens to commit or cause to be committed a specified offense against a police officer and thereby causes a reasonable expectation or fear of the imminent commission of such offense against a police officer.
- 2. It shall be no defense to a prosecution pursuant to this section that the defendant did not have the intent or capability of committing the specified offense or that the threat was not made to a person who was a subject thereof.
- 16 <u>Making a terroristic threat against a police officer is a class C</u>
  17 <u>felony.</u>
- 18 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-19 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
