AN ACT directing the commissioner of the office of parks, recreation and historic preservation to conduct a legal review for the re-designation of Donald J. Trump State Park, in Putnam and Westchester counties to a new name

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The commissioner of the office of parks, recreation and historic preservation shall conduct a legal review of the re-designation of Donald J. Trump State Park, in Putnam and Westchester counties, to determine whether the authority exists to change the name of such park. Within one year of the effective date of this act, the commissioner shall submit the findings of such review to the governor, the temporary president of the senate, and the speaker of the assembly. If such review determines that such legal authority exists, the commissioner shall change the name of such park. In the event the name of such park is changed, the office of parks, recreation and historic preservation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of appropriate signage and any other administrative actions necessary to implement the name change and to improve the park for the enjoyment of the public.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
