AN ACT to amend the penal law, in relation to the unlawful dissemination of a security body scan

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The penal law is amended by adding a new section 250.72 to 2 read as follows:
- 3 § 250.72 Unlawful dissemination of a security body scan.
- A person is guilty of unlawful dissemination of a body scan, when he 5 or she, without the permission of the person of whom the scan was made,
- 6 knowingly disseminates a body scan taken for legal security purposes, or 7
- any image or images derived from such scan, to any person who has not been authorized to receive such scan pursuant to state or federal stat-
- 9 <u>ute or regulation.</u>
- 10 Unlawful dissemination of a security body scan is a class A misdemea-11 <u>nor.</u>
- 12 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of November next succeed-
- 13 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
