AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to the removal of incarcerated individuals diagnosed with mental illness to a residential mental health treatment unit

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

## Section 1. Subparagraph (i) of paragraph d of subdivision 6 of section 137 of the correction law, as separately amended by chapters 93 and 322 3 of the laws of 2021, is amended to read as follows:

4 (i) Except as set forth in clause (E) of subparagraph (ii) of this 5 paragraph, the department, in consultation with mental health clinicians, shall divert or remove an incarcerated [individuals] individual б 7 who at any time has been diagnosed with a serious mental illness, as 8 defined in subparagraphs (i), (iii), (iv) and (v) of paragraph (e) of 9 this subdivision, from segregated confinement or confinement in a resi-10 dential rehabilitation unit, where such confinement could potentially be 11 for a period in excess of thirty days, to a residential mental health treatment unit. Nothing in this paragraph shall be deemed to prevent the 12 13 disciplinary process from proceeding in accordance with department rules 14 and regulations for disciplinary hearings.

15 § 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 16 have become a law.
