AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to the age requirement for voting in a primary election

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

 Section 1. Section 5-102 of the election law is amended by adding a new subdivision 3 to read as follows:
<u>3. The provisions herein with respect to the age requirement for</u> purposes of qualifying to vote shall not prohibit United States citizens otherwise qualified, who are seventeen years of age, from voting in a primary election, including a presidential primary, if such citizen will be eighteen years of age by the date of the corresponding general election.

9 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
