AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring new teachers to have completed training for evidence-based reading instruction

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 3004 of the education law is amended by adding a 2 new subdivision 7 to read as follows:
- 3 7. a. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the commissioner
- 4 shall prescribe regulations requiring that all persons applying, on or after January first, two thousand twenty-five, for a certificate or
- license to be a childhood education teacher, early education teacher,
- special education teacher, or reading specialist shall, in addition to all other certification or licensure requirements, have completed two
- 9 hours of coursework or training in evidence-based reading instruction.
- Such coursework shall include education on: 10
- 11 i. language acquisition;
- 12 ii. literacy development;
- 13 iii. phonological processing;
- 14 iv. phonics and word recognition development;
- 15 v. spelling;
- vi. fluency and automaticity development; 16
- 17 vii. vocabulary development;
- viii. text comprehension development; 18
- ix. assessment administration and interpretation; 19
- 20 x. letter formation;
- 21 xi. orthographic processing;
- 2.2 xii. morphological awareness;
- xiii. structure of language; 23
- 24 xiv. language based learning disabilities;
- 2.5 xv. written expression; and
