AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to requiring limited use motorcycles to be registered at point of sale

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 2261 of the vehicle and traffic law is amended by adding a new subdivision 6 to read as follows:

6. Registration at time of sale. Every limited use motorcycle, as defined by section one hundred twenty-one-b of this chapter, sold by a dealer shall be registered at the time of sale of such vehicle. Such registration shall be valid until the thirty-first day of August following the date of such sale; provided, however, that any limited use motorcycle sold after April first of each year shall be issued a registration valid until the thirty-first day of August in the year following that in which the limited use motorcycle is sold. Any limited use motorcycle purchased for use exclusively outside of the state of New York shall not require registration at the time of purchase, and the purchaser of such limited use motorcycles shall sign a declaration, provided by the dealer, which shall state that such purchaser understands the conditions under which a limited use motorcycle must be registered and the penalty for violation of such registration provisions. Each signed declaration shall be forwarded by the dealer to the commissioner. The form of such declaration shall be provided by the commissioner to each dealer.

§ 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall have become a law.
