AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to requiring navigation systems utilizing GPS technology to identify the height of any bridge or overpass along a proposed route

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section
2 390-f to read as follows:

3 § 390-f. Global positioning system navigation. No electronic map or
4 navigation system which utilizes global positioning system (GPS) tech-
5 nology to direct the driver of a motor vehicle to a specified destina-
6 tion along a proposed route or routes shall be offered for use or sale
7 in this state unless such map or navigation system provides the actual
8 height of each bridge or overpass along a proposed route generated in
9 response to a request or information provided by a user.

10 § 2. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day after
11 it shall have become a law.
