Introduced by M. of A. CONRAD -- read once and referred to the Committee on Local Governments

AN ACT to amend the general municipal law, in relation to authorizing matching funding for savings achieved for actions between local governments that are later included as part of an approved county-wide shared services plan

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Subdivision 8 of section 239-bb of the general municipal
2 law, as amended by chapter 717 of the laws of 2022, is amended to read
3 as follows:

4 8. For each county, new shared services actions in an approved and
5 submitted plan pursuant to this section or part BBB of chapter fifty-
6 nine of the laws of two thousand seventeen, may be eligible for funding
7 to match savings from such action, subject to available appropriation.
8 Savings that are actually and demonstrably realized by the participating
9 local governments are eligible for matching funding. For actions that
10 are part of an approved plan transmitted to the secretary of state in
11 accordance with paragraph b of subdivision seven of this section,
12 savings achieved during either: (i) January first through December thir-
13 ty-first from new actions implemented on or after January first through
14 December thirty-first of the year immediately following an approved and
15 transmitted plan, or (ii) July first of the year immediately following
16 an approved and transmitted plan through June thirtieth of the subse-
17 quent year from new actions implemented July first of the year imme-
18 diately following an approved plan through June thirtieth of the subse-
19 quent year may be eligible for matching funding. Savings achieved for
20 actions between local governments that are later included as a part of
21 an approved plan transmitted to the secretary of state shall be eligible
22 for matching funding. Only net savings between local governments for
23 each action would be eligible for matching funding. Savings from inter-
24 nal efficiencies or any other action taken by a local government without
25 the participation of another local government are not eligible for
26 matching funding. Each county and all of the local governments within

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1 the county that are part of any action to be implemented as part of an
2 approved plan must collectively apply for the matching funding and agree
3 on the distribution and use of any matching funding in order to qualify
4 for matching funding.
5 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
