AN ACT to amend the tax law and the environmental conservation law, in relation to establishing a bivalve mollusk shell recycling tax credit

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 210-B of the tax law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 59 to read as follows:

59. Bivalve mollusk shell recycling credit. A taxpayer shall be allowed a credit, to be computed as hereinafter provided against the tax imposed by this article, for the recycling of bivalve mollusk shells. The amount of the credit shall be the lesser of one thousand dollars, or ten cents multiplied by the number of pounds of mollusk shells certified 8 by the New York state department of environmental conservation. The credit allowed under this subdivision for any taxable year shall not 10 reduce the tax due for such year to less than the fixed dollar minimum amount prescribed in paragraph (d) of subdivision one of section two hundred ten of this article. In order for a taxpayer to qualify for this credit, the shells shall be donated to an entity or organization permitted by the department of environmental conservation to reuse such shells for the beneficial use of oyster reef restoration.

§ 2. Section 606 of the tax law is amended by adding a new subsection (ooo) to read as follows:

18 (000) Bivalve mollusk shell recycling credit. (1) A taxpayer shall be allowed a credit, to be computed as hereinafter provided against the tax 19 20 imposed by this article, for the recycling of bivalve mollusk shells.

(2) The amount of the credit shall be the lesser of one thousand 21 22 dollars, or ten cents multiplied by the number of pounds of bivalve
