Introduced by M. of A. SOLAGES -- read once and referred to the Committee on Environmental Conservation

AN ACT to amend the environmental conservation law, in relation to increasing sales of zero-emission vehicles

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 19-0306-b of the environmental conservation law is amended by adding a new subdivision 6 to read as follows:

6. a. (i) The department, the New York state energy research and 3 4 development authority, the department of motor vehicles, and the depart-5 ment of transportation, in consultation with the other state agencies, 6 shall report on December thirty-first, two thousand twenty-four and on a 7 bi-annual basis thereafter until December thirty-first, two thousand thirty-four, the state's zero-emission vehicle sales by new motor vehi-8 cle dealers, as defined in section four hundred fifteen of the vehicle 9 10 and traffic law, except for manufacturers that manufacture or assemble 11 exclusively zero-emissions vehicles, or is a subsidiary, affiliate, or controlled entity of such a manufacturer, as outlined in subparagraph 12 13 (iii) of paragraph f of subdivision seven of such section.

(ii) Notwithstanding any provision of subparagraph (iii) of paragraph 14 f of subdivision seven of section four hundred fifteen of the vehicle 15 16 and traffic law, if the department finds in its initial report that 17 projections of sales by new motor vehicle dealers, except for manufacturers that manufacture or assemble exclusively zero-emissions vehicles, 18 or is a subsidiary, affiliate, or controlled entity of such a manufac-19 turer, fail to show that thirty-five percent of vehicle sales in model 20 21 year two thousand twenty-six will be zero-emission vehicles then the 22 department of motor vehicles shall issue up to ten certificates of 23 registration pursuant to section four hundred fifteen of the vehicle and 24 traffic law for entities that manufacture or assemble zero-emissions 25 vehicles and have no franchised motor vehicle dealers in New York.

b. If the bi-annual report on December thirty-first, two thousand
twenty-eight finds projections of sales by new motor vehicle dealers,
except for manufacturers that manufacture or assemble exclusively zero-

emissions vehicles, or is a subsidiary, affiliate, or controlled entity 1 of such a manufacturer, fail to show that sixty-eight percent of sales 2 by model year two thousand thirty will be zero-emissions vehicles then 3 the department of motor vehicles shall issue up to ten additional 4 5 certificates of registration pursuant to section four hundred fifteen of 6 the vehicle and traffic law for entities that manufacture or assemble 7 zero-emissions vehicles and have no franchised motor vehicle dealers in 8 New York. 9 c. If the bi-annual report on December thirty-first, two thousand 10 thirty-three finds projections of sales by new motor vehicle dealers, 11 except for manufacturers that manufacture or assemble exclusively zero-12 emissions vehicles, or is a subsidiary, affiliate, or controlled entity of such a manufacturer, fail to show that one hundred percent of sales 13

14 by model year two thousand thirty-five will be zero-emissions vehicles 15 then the department of motor vehicles shall issue up to ten additional

16 certificates of registration pursuant to section four hundred fifteen of

17 the vehicle and traffic law for entities that manufacture or assemble

18 zero-emissions vehicles and have no franchised motor vehicle dealers in

20 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
