AN ACT to amend the alcoholic beverage control law, in relation to prohibiting the state liquor authority from conditioning a liquor license based on a cabaret law that has been repealed by a local jurisdiction

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 114 of the alcoholic beverage control law is 2 amended by adding a new subdivision 7 to read as follows:
- 7. The liquor authority shall not deny an application for a license or for renewal of a license pursuant to the provisions of this chapter, or
- 5 impose a condition on the issuance of such license, including requiring
- 6 the applicant to apply for a cabaret license, based upon a cabaret law
- 7 that has been repealed by a local jurisdiction or where local zoning
- 8 laws do not specifically prohibit dancing or music, or require issuance
- 9 of a permit to allow such activity.
- 10 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
