AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to requiring certain individuals to file financial disclosure forms

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The opening paragraph of paragraph (a) of subdivision 2 of section 73-a of the public officers law, as amended by section 7 of part QQ of chapter 56 of the laws of 2022, is amended to read as follows:

Every statewide elected official, state officer or employee, member of the legislature, legislative employee and political party chair [and],
