AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to requiring food service establishments disclose if they are operating out of another food service establishment's kitchen or in a location which is not operated exclusively as a kitchen for such food service establishment

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section
2 350-f-2 to read as follows:

3 § 350-f-2. Disclosures required for certain food service establishments. 1. For purposes of this section:

4 (a) "Food service establishment" means a place where food is provided
5 for individual portion service directly to the consumer whether such
6 food is provided free of charge or sold, and whether consumption occurs
7 on or off the premises or is provided from a pushcart, stand or vehicle.

8 (b) "Third-party food delivery service" means any website, mobile
9 application or other internet service that offers or arranges for the
10 sale or delivery of food and beverages prepared by, and the same-day
11 delivery or same-day pickup of food and beverage from, a food service
12 establishment located in the state.

13 (c) "Third-party food delivery platform" means the online or mobile
14 platform of the third-party food delivery service on which a consumer
15 can view products available for sale and place an order for a food
16 service establishment's products.

17 2. Any food service establishment, in making representations for the
18 purposes of inducing, or which are likely to induce, directly or indi-
19 rectly, the purchase of food from such establishment, shall clearly and
20 prominently disclose, in any advertisement, on such establishment's
21 website, mobile application or other internet service, and on any third-
22 party food delivery platform, if such establishment is operating out of
23 a different food service establishment's kitchen or in a location which
24 is not operated exclusively as a kitchen for such food service estab-
25 lishment.

26 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall
27 have become a law.
