- AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Sergeant James S. Hayes Memorial Highway"

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-p to read as follows:

§ 344-p. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the "Sergeant James S. Hayes Memorial Highway". All that portion of the state highway system constituting state route 14 beginning at the interesection of state route 14 and Plum Point Road in the town of Milo, county of Yates, continuing in a generally northerly direction, and terminating at the intersection of state route 14 and state route 54, also known as Main Street, in the village of Dresden, county of Yates, shall be designated and known as the "Sergeant James S. Hayes Memorial Highway".

§ 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the installation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the designation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of ceremonial nature and the official name of such highway shall not be changed as a result of this act.

19 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
