AN ACT making appropriations for the support of government; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Legislative intent. The legislature hereby finds and 2 declares that the enactment of these appropriations provides sufficient 3 authority to the comptroller for the purpose of making payments for the 4 purposes described herein until such time as appropriation bills submit-5 ted by the governor pursuant to article VII of the state constitution 6 for the support of government for the state fiscal year beginning April 7 1, 2024 are enacted.

8 § 2. The amounts specified in this section, or so much thereof as 9 shall be sufficient to accomplish the purposes designated, is hereby 10 appropriated and authorized to be paid as hereinafter provided, to the 11 public officers and for the purpose specified, which amount shall be 12 available for the state fiscal year beginning April 1, 2024.

ALL STATE DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES

14 For the purpose of making payments for 15 personal service, including liabilities 16 incurred prior to April 1, 2024, on the 17 payrolls scheduled to be paid during the 18 period April 1 through April 4, 2024 to 19 state officers and employees of the execu-20 tive branch. This appropriation also 21 includes funding for payment of health 22 care and mental hygiene bonuses to eligible state employees, and payments for 23 services performed by mentally ill or 24 25 developmentally disabled persons who are 26 employed in state-operated special employ-

The amounts specified in this section, or so much thereof as shall be sufficient to accomplish the purposes designated, is hereby 34 35 appropriated and authorized to be paid as hereinafter provided, to the public officers and for the purposes specified, which amount shall be 36 37 available for the state fiscal year beginning April 1, 2024.

§ 7. No expenditure may be made from any appropriation in this act, until a certificate of approval has been issued by the director of the budget and a copy of such certificate shall have been filed with the state comptroller, the chairman of the senate finance committee and the chairman of the assembly ways and means committee provided, however, that any expenditures from any appropriation in this act made by the legislature or judiciary shall not require such certificate.

§ 8. All expenditures and disbursements made against the appropriations in this act shall, upon final action by the legislature on appropriation bills submitted by the governor pursuant to article VII of the state constitution for the support of government for the state fiscal year beginning April 1, 2024, be transferred by the comptroller as expenditures and disbursements to such appropriations for all state departments and agencies, as applicable, in amounts equal to the amounts charged against the appropriations in this act for each such department, agency, and the legislature and the judiciary.

§ 9. Severability clause. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this act shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered. It is hereby declared to be the intent of

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1 the legislature that this act would have been enacted even if such 2 invalid provisions had not been included herein.

3 § 10. This act shall take effect immediately and shall be deemed to 4 have been in full force and effect on and after April 1, 2024; provided, 5 however, that upon the transfer of expenditures and disbursements by the 6 comptroller as provided in section eight of this act, the appropriations 7 made by this act and subject to such section shall be deemed repealed.
