AN ACT to amend the social services law, in relation to medical assistance for patients in the process of oral or injectable ovulation enhancing drugs

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (ee) of subdivision 2 of section 365-a of the social services law, as added by section 4 of part S of chapter 57 of the laws of 2017, is amended to read as follows:

(ee) Medical assistance shall include the coverage of a set of services to ensure improved outcomes of [women] patients who are in the process of oral or injectable ovulation enhancing drugs, limited to the provision of such treatment, office visits, hysterosalpingogram services, pelvic ultrasounds, and blood testing; services shall be limited to those necessary to monitor such treatment. In the event that ninety percent federal financial participation for such services is not available, the state share of appropriations related to these services shall be used for a grant program intended to accomplish the purpose of this section.

14 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 15 have become a law.
