Introduced by M. of A. JACKSON -- read once and referred to the Committee on Election Law

AN ACT to amend the election law, in relation to requiring early voting occurs on the Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays, and Tuesdays prior to the election within the early voting period

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraphs (c) and (d) of subdivision 4 of section 8-600 of
2 the election law, paragraph (c) as amended by chapter 781 of the laws of
3 2021 and paragraph (d) as added by chapter 6 of the laws of 2019, are
4 amended to read as follows:

5 (c) Polls shall be open for early voting for at least eight hours
6 between nine o'clock in the morning and eight o'clock in the evening on
7 each Friday, Saturday, Sunday and [~~legal holiday~~] Tuesday during the
8 early voting period.

9 (d) Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit any board
10 of elections from establishing a greater number of hours for voting
11 during the early voting period beyond the number of hours required in
12 this subdivision; provided however, no board of elections shall establish days where early voting is permitted besides those permitted in
13 paragraph (c) of this subdivision.

14 § 2. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeeding
15 the date on which it shall have become a law. Effective immediately,
16 the addition, amendment and/or repeal of any rule or regulation necessary
17 for the implementation of this act on its effective date are
18 authorized to be made and completed on or before such effective date.
