AN ACT to amend the cannabis law, in relation to certain medical cannabis reforms

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 32 of the cannabis law is amended by adding a new 2 subdivision 17 to read as follows:
- 17. A person who is not a resident of this state, but who is authorized to engage in the medical use of cannabis under the laws of his or
 her state or jurisdiction of residence, is deemed to hold a valid registry identification if the person provides legitimate documentation and
 abides by the legal limits on the possession, delivery and production of
- 7 abides by the legal limits on the possession, delivery and production of 8 cannabis for medical purposes in this state, as set forth in section
- 9 thirty-one of this article. The board shall make regulations to imple-
- 10 ment the provisions of this subdivision and may enter into reciprocity 11 agreements with other states with medical cannabis programs.
- 12 § 2. Section 13 of the cannabis law is amended by adding a new subdi-13 vision 7 to read as follows:
- 7. The board shall promulgate regulations for the approval of pre-roll products in the medical cannabis program.
- 16 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
