AN ACT to amend the civil practice law and rules, in relation to exempting a person from a money judgment arising from an action in another state for knowingly engaging in conduct that aids or abets the performance or inducement of an abortion

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Section 5205 of the civil practice law and rules is amended by adding a new subdivision (q) to read as follows:
- 3 (q) Any personal property, including but not limited to income, owned 4 by a person who is subject to a money judgment arising from an action in 5 another state for knowingly engaging in conduct that aids or abets the 6 performance or inducement of an abortion is exempt from application to 7 the satisfaction of such money judgment.
- 8 § 2. Section 5206 of the civil practice law and rules is amended by adding a new subdivision (g) to read as follows:
- 10 (g) Any real property owned by a person who is subject to a money 11 judgment arising from an action in another state for knowingly engaging
- 12 in conduct that aids or abets the performance or inducement of an
- 13 abortion is exempt from application to the satisfaction of such money
- 14 judgment.
- 15 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
