AN ACT to amend the public health law and the social services law, in relation to authorizing residents of assisted living programs to receive hospice services

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 4 of section 4012 of the public health law, as added by a chapter of the laws of 2022 amending the public health law and the social services law relating to authorizing residents of assisted living programs to receive hospice services, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 7626 and A. 8006, is amended to read as follows:

4. Eligible individuals shall be permitted to receive hospice services from a provider under this article while continuing to reside in an adult care facility under title two of article seven of the social services law and enrolled in the assisted living program, subject to the availability of federal financial participation. The commissioner shall make regulations and take other actions reasonably necessary and appropriate to implement this subdivision.

§ 2. Subparagraph (iv) of paragraph (d) of subdivision 2 of section 461-l of the social services law, as added by a chapter of the laws of 2022 amending the public health law and the social services law relating to authorizing residents of assisted living programs to receive hospice services, as proposed in legislative bills numbers S. 7626 and A. 8006, is amended to read as follows:

(iv) Eligible individuals shall be permitted to receive hospice services from a provider under article forty of the public health law while continuing to reside in an adult care facility under this title and enrolled in the assisted living program, subject to the availability of federal financial participation. The commissioner shall make regu-
