AN ACT to require the director of information technology services to undertake a detailed study of the comparative qualities of cloud computing services and state data center operations

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The director of information technology services, in consultation with the advisory council for technology, shall contract with an independent entity to conduct a detailed study of the comparative qualities of cloud computing services and state data center operations. Such contract shall be awarded on a competitive basis through a request for proposals process. Such study shall include, but not be limited to the following comparative analyses: cost, value, operational risks, privacy, security, reliability, redundancy and disaster recovery. Such report shall be submitted to the governor, state comptroller, the temporary president of the senate and the speaker of the assembly no later than May 31, 2024.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
