AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to requiring an education campaign about the 9-8-8 suicide and crisis lifeline and the crisis text line

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. Short title. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "student lifeline act".
- § 2. The education law is amended by adding a new section 207-b to 4 read as follows:
- § 207-b. Crisis resources. Each degree-granting institution of higher 6 education shall establish an education campaign to educate students, faculty, and staff about the 9-8-8 suicide and crisis lifeline and the 8 crisis text line. Such education campaign shall include, but not be limited to:
- 10 1. resources describing when to utilize the 9-8-8 suicide and crisis lifeline and the crisis text line; and 11 12
- 2. contact information for such services on student identification 13 cards, or the annual distribution of contact information for such 14 services at institutions that do not issue student identification cards.
- 15 § 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2025 and shall apply to student identification cards that are issued, modified, altered or 16 amended on or after such date.
