AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to prohibiting state officers and employees from official involvement with a state project where the officer or employee acted as a consultant on such project

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Subdivision 3 of section 74 of the public officers law is amended by adding a new paragraph j to read as follows:

j. No officer or employee of a state agency shall perform any official duty or function, including but not limited to the exercise of discretion or other decision making normally attendant to his or her office, or otherwise act in any official capacity or discharge any duties with respect to a project funded by the state where such officer 8 or employee has previously entered into a contract for consulting 9 services involving such project prior to his or her employment with such 10 state agency. For the purposes of this section, a "contract for consult-11 ing services" shall mean any contract entered into by a state agency for 12 <u>analysis</u>, <u>evaluation</u>, <u>research</u>, <u>training</u>, <u>data processing</u>, <u>computer</u> 13 programming, engineering, environmental health and mental health 14 <u>services</u>, <u>accounting</u>, <u>auditing</u>, <u>paralegal</u>, <u>legal</u>, <u>or similar services</u>.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
