- AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to developing grow your own initiatives at school districts and boards of cooperative educational services

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1	Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "teach-
2	ers and educators aiding the communities they call home (TEACH) act".
3	§ 2. Section 305 of the education law is amended by adding a new
4	subdivision 60 to read as follows:
5	60. The commissioner, in consultation with institutions of higher
б	education, shall issue guidance for school districts and boards of coop-
7	erative educational services to use to develop grow your own initiatives

10	(a) ways to recruit underrepresented candidates, including those who

13	(b) initiatives aimed at creating an early recruitment pipeline begin-

15	(c) how to establish partnerships between school districts, communi-
16	ty-based organizations, and institutions of higher education to encour-
