AN ACT to amend the general business law, in relation to requiring businesses which provide for someone to spoof a telephone number to keep certain records

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The general business law is amended by adding a new section 2 399-rr to read as follows:
- § 399-rr. Telephone number spoofing recordkeeping. 1. For the purposes of this section, "spoofing of a telephone number" shall mean having the caller information displayed on a caller identification device be information other than that of the actual telephone number being used to place the call.
- 8 2. Every business which provides for the spoofing of a telephone
  9 number shall keep a record of the calls placed using its services
  10 including, but not limited to:
- 11 (a) the phone number that would be displayed on the caller identifica-12 tion device of the person receiving the phone call;
- 13 (b) the telephone number or internet protocol address of the device 14 placing the telephone call; and
- 15 (c) the time, date, and duration of the telephone call.
- 16 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 17 have become a law.
