AN ACT to amend the correction law, in relation to educational leave for eligible incarcerated individuals

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 7 of section 851 of the correction law, as 2 amended by chapter 322 of the laws of 2021, is amended to read as 3 follows:
- 7. "Educational leave" means a privilege granted to an eligible incarcerated individual to leave the premises of an institution for a period
  not exceeding fourteen hours in any day for the purpose of education or
  vocational training, or for any matter necessary to the furtherance of
  any such purposes. For purposes of this subdivision, as applied under
  this chapter, an eligible incarcerated individual shall include an
  incarcerated individual who is within two years of being an eligible
  incarcerated individual.
- 12 § 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after it shall 13 have become a law; provided, however, that the amendments to subdivision 14 7 of section 851 of the correction law made by section one of this act 15 shall not affect the expiration of such section and shall be deemed to 16 expire therewith.
