AN ACT to amend the criminal procedure law, in relation to qualifying offenses for pre-trial detention

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Paragraph (d) of subdivision 4 of section 510.10 of the 2 criminal procedure law, as amended by section 2 of part UU of chapter 56 of the laws of 2020, is amended to read as follows:

(d) a class A felony defined in the penal law, [provided that for 5 class A felonics under article two hundred twenty of the penal law, only 6 class A-I felonies or a class B felony defined in article two hundred twenty of the penal law shall be a qualifying offense;

§ 2. This act shall take effect on the thirtieth day after it shall 9 have become a law.
