AN ACT to amend the public authorities law, in relation to establishing a home heating oil rebate program; and providing for the repeal of such provisions upon expiration thereof

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. The public authorities law is amended by adding a new 2 section 1885 to read as follows:
- § 1885. Home heating oil rebate program. 1. The authority is hereby authorized to establish and administer a home heating oil rebate program. The authority shall be responsible for gathering all necessary residential customer purchase data from all registered home heating oil dealers in the state.
- 2. The authority shall have the responsibility of distributing rebate checks to residential home heating oil customers. Such rebate shall be in the amount of one dollar per gallon, up to a limit of five hundred gallons, of number two heating oil purchased between the dates of July first, two thousand twenty-three and June thirtieth, two thousand twenty-four.
- 3. The authority shall promulgate rules and regulations for the administration of a home heating oil rebate program established pursuant to this section, including but not limited to eligibility criteria, application procedures, and documentation and compliance requirements for the program.
- 19 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately and shall expire December 20 31, 2024 when upon such date the provisions of this act shall be deemed 21 repealed.
