AN ACT to amend the vehicle and traffic law, in relation to prohibiting municipalities from transferring primary investigating authority of vehicle collisions that result in serious injury or death to a non-law enforcement agency

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The opening paragraph of subdivision 1 of section 603-a of 2 the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by chapter 489 of the laws of 2017, is amended to read as follows:

In addition to the requirements of section six hundred three of this article, whenever a motor vehicle accident results in serious physical injury or death to a person, [and such ascident either is discovered by a police officer, or reported to a police officer within five days after 8 such assident oscurred, the police shall conduct an investigation of 9 such accident. No municipality shall transfer such primary investigat-10 <u>ing authority to a non-law enforcement agency.</u>

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
