AN ACT to amend the highway law, in relation to designating a portion of the state highway system as the "Zone Sergeant James G. Sweeney Memorial Bridge"

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. The highway law is amended by adding a new section 344-o to read as follows:

- § 344-o. Portion of the state highway system to be designated as the "Zone Sergeant James G. Sweeney Memorial Bridge". All that portion of 5 the state highway system constituting the bridge on Lime Kiln Road, 6 crossing interstate route eighty-four in the town of East Fishkill, county of Dutchess, shall be designated and known as the "Zone Sergeant James G. Sweeney Memorial Bridge".
- § 2. The commissioner of transportation shall provide for the instal-9 lation and maintenance of adequate signing of the state highway system 10 as designated pursuant to section one of this act. However, to avoid 11 confusion and to limit any possible disruption of commerce, the desig-13 nation called for pursuant to section one of this act shall be one of 14 ceremonial nature and the official name of such bridge shall not be 15 changed as a result of this act.
  - § 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
