AN ACT to amend the labor law, in relation to inventions made by employ-

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- Section 1. The labor law is amended by adding a new section 203-f to
- 2 read as follows: 3 § 203-f. Inventions made by employees. 1. Any provision in an employ-
- 4 ment agreement which provides that an employee shall assign, or offer to 5 assign, any of his or her rights in an invention to his or her employer
- shall not apply to an invention that the employee developed entirely on
- 7 his or her own time without using the employer's equipment, supplies,
- 8 facilities, or trade secret information except for those inventions that 9 <u>either:</u>
- 10 (a) relate at the time of conception or reduction to practice of the
- 11 invention to the employer's business, or actual or demonstrably anticipated research or development of the employer; or
- 12
- 13 (b) result from any work performed by the employee for the employer.
- 14 2. To the extent a provision in an employment agreement purports to
- 15 require an employee to assign an invention otherwise excluded from being
- 16 required to be assigned under subdivision one of this section, such
- 17 provision is against the public policy of this state and shall be unen-
- 18 forceable.
- 19 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
