AN ACT to amend the general construction law and the education law, in relation to the designation of Good Friday as a public holiday

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 24 of the general construction law, as amended by chapter 249 of the laws of 2020, is amended to read as follows:

2 § 24. Public holidays; half-holidays. The term public holiday includes the following days in each year: the first day of January, known as New Year's day; the third Monday of January, known as Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. day; the twelfth day of February, known as Lincoln's birthday; the third Monday in February, known as Washington's birthday; the Friday immediately before Easter, known as Good Friday; the last Monday in May, 9 known as Memorial day; the second Sunday in June, known as Flag day; the 10 nineteenth day of June, known as Juneteenth; the fourth day of July, 11 known as Independence day; the first Monday in September, known as Labor 12 day; the second Monday in October, known as Columbus day; the eleventh day of November, known as Veterans' day; the fourth Thursday in Novem-13 14 ber, known as Thanksgiving day; and the twenty-fifth day of December, known as Christmas day, and if any of such days except Flag day is Sunday, the next day thereafter; each general election day, and each day 16 appointed by the president of the United States or by the governor of 17 this state as a day of general thanksgiving, general fasting and prayer, 18 or other general religious observances. The term half-holiday includes 19 20 the period from noon to midnight of each Saturday which is not a public 21 holiday.

22 § 2. The education law is amended by adding a new section 3204-a to 23 read as follows:

§ 3204-a. Good Friday school holiday. 1. The Friday immediately before
Easter, commonly known as Good Friday, shall be declared a holiday for
all public schools.

- 2. The term "Good Friday" shall replace "Spring Recess" and similar terminology on all public school district calendars and communications that reference Good Friday.
- 7 § 3. Section 3604 of the education law is amended by adding a new 8 subdivision 7-a to read as follows:
- 11 commissioner shall disregard any reduction resulting from the observance
- 12 of Good Friday and, if necessary, such observed holiday shall be calcu-
- 13 <u>lated as a session day.</u>

14 § 4. This act shall take effect on the first of January next succeed-15 ing the date on which it shall have become a law.
