AN ACT to amend the civil practice law and rules, in relation to establishing venue in actions to recover student debt

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 503 of the civil practice law and rules is amended by adding a new subdivision (g) to read as follows:

(g) Student debt. In an action to recover tuition, fees, room and board, educational benefit payments, student loans, or other such charges incurred by a student in furtherance of such student's education owed to the state of New York, the place of trial shall be the residence of a defendant, if one resides within the state, or, in other cases, as set

9 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
