AN ACT to amend the public officers law, in relation to waiving the residency requirement for the commissioner of planning, development, and public transportation for Putnam county

The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. Section 3 of the public officers law is amended by adding a new subdivision 73 to read as follows:

73. In the county of Putnam, the provisions of this section requiring a person to be a resident of the political subdivision or municipal corporation of the state for which he or she shall be chosen or within which his or her official functions are required to be exercised, shall not prevent a person from holding the office of commissioner of planning, development, and public transportation of the county of Putnam, provided that such person resides in Putnam county or an adjoining county within the state of New York; provided, however that any person performing such functions or holding the office of commissioner of planning, development, and public transportation in any other county shall be a resident of such county unless otherwise provided by law.

§ 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
