AN ACT to amend the education law, in relation to the provision of applications for registration to licensees by the state education department

## The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Subdivision 2 of section 6502 of the education law, as 2 amended by chapter 81 of the laws of 1995, is amended to read as 3 follows:
- 2. The department shall establish the beginning dates of the registration periods for each profession and [mail] provide an application for registration conforming to the requirements of section 3-503 of the general obligations law to every licensee currently registered at least four months prior to the beginning of the registration period for the respective profession; provided however, the department shall mail an application forty-five days prior to the end date of such registration
- 11 period to any licensee who has not registered.
- 12 § 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
